3 Stony Batter Tunnels

Explore the unique underworld of Fort Stony Batter, taking you back in time through 1.2km's of subterranean WWII tunnels. Built in the 1940s, the site features an extensive network of underground tunnels, gun emplacements, and observation posts. Learn about history while enjoying the surrounding scenic reserve, known for its distinctive volcanic rock formations and panoramic views. Please note a moderate level of fitness is recommended. There is a 1km walk across easy farm terrain to the entrance, walking shoes recommended.

On-island pick-ups

Purchase your tickets through our call centre (+64 9 367 9111) or at the Matiatia ticket office, and let them know your desired pick-up location, either Oneroa - Waiheke Library bus stop, or Onetangi - Four Square bus stop. Tickets purchased online will automatically include pick-up from the Matiatia Ferry Terminal.













Eastern Explorer Hop-On Hop-Off bus will not stop at these destinations. Advanced bookings are advisable for Fullers360 tours. If you are planning to dine on Waiheke Island, please book the venue in advance of travel to avoid disappointment. Arrive at the Downtown Ferry Terminal at least 30 ninutes prior to ferry departure for boarding. In summer, we recommend allowing at least 60 minutes. Tour details

- > Eastern Explorer Hop-On Hop-Off bus: Buses depart Matiatia Ferry Terminal every 60 minutes, with more frequent returns from the eastern end of the island. The timetable is designed to visit key locations, offering 9 convenient stops along the way. Alternatively, stay on board for a scenic 110-minute tour, where your friendly driver-quide will share fascinating island history and insider tips to help you plan your perfect day.
- > Discover the flavours of Waiheke Island: Must-visit locations include the historic Stony Batter Tunnels, Man O' War Vineyard, Waiheke Distilling Co., Passage Rock Wines and Awaroa Organic Winery.
- > **Duration:** We recommend allowing at full day, including ferry travel to and from downtown Auckland.
- > Departure time: Each Eastern Explorer Hop-On Hop-Off bus arrives at Matiatia Ferry Terminal to meet the ferry. The first bus meets the 9am sailing from downtown Auckland. The final bus will return passengers to the ferry terminal to meet the 6:30pm sailing back to downtown Auckland.
- > Ferry travel: Please allow ample time to catch your preferred ferry. For more certainty, choose the Waiheke Reserve bookable service. Alternatively, opt for the Waiheke Walk-up ferry, an on-demand service, and plan to arrive at least 60 minutes prior to your preferred departure time, especially during the busy summer period.
